Description

The matched pair 8009 microphone consists of two omni-directional microphones, both with individual specifications as noted in datasheet 8009 and matched so that the deviation in sensitivity between both microphones at the frequencies indicated below does not exceed the tabulated values.



Matching

The lagging microphone is marked with a black dot on the case and has a phase difference at 250 Hz (Delta Phase = Phase lagging - Phase leading) of +0.2° to -1.5° with respect to the unmarked microphone.


